Oral Hygiene Instructions

Brush your teeth daily whenever you are able to, using short circular strokes and a fluoride toothpaste, making sure you clean the margins of the gums. A rotatingoscillating (not a sonic) electric toothbrush (Oral-B[™] 600 or Oral-B[™] Vitality) can be beneficial.

The spaces between the teeth can be cleaned with spiral inter-dental (TePe[™]) brushes (). Bleeding gums are a sign of gum inflammation or disease and should be brushed more thoroughly and carefully to ensure the inflammation regresses.

You may have been prescribed a high fluoride toothpaste. This is to be used regularly instead of your regular toothpaste twice daily for 3 months. A smear of toothpaste should be sufficient and there is no need to rinse the mouth following brushing.
